On Mission for God

"But those who were scattered went everywhere announcing the Gospel." Acts 8:4

It has been two years since we were invited by families living in the area north of Jinotega, Nicaragua, near the border with the Republic of Honduras. We began to ask God to open the doors for us to be able to go to this place. When we felt it was the right time, we began to look for airline tickets, money to purchase bags, pencils, clothing, Bibles, devotional materials, crayons, plastic chairs, kitchen utensils, etc., for pastors and teachers there. We checked to see if we could find 4 X 4 vehicles to get to those places where most people can access only by horse or on foot. There was a caravan waiting for us, and after resting for the night, we set out to go to a very large community tucked in the mountains of Jinotega and Zelaya called WASLALA. The trip up into the mountains lasted 17 hours, during which time we had many problems with the truck we were driving. We were in that area three days, but when told by some of the shepherds, who came to share the studies, that there were drug dealers in the area who often steal and kill or kidnap visitors, we were quite alarmed and asked God what we should do. That night, I was very restless and God spoke to me in my dreams the following Bible warning: "The wise man sees danger and runs." That message persisted throughout the day Monday, so I had an emergency meeting with the group that accompanied me. I shared with them that I felt it was necessary for us to leave such a dangerous place. They all agreed. So, very early on Tuesday we left quickly to return to Jinotega, and Managua.

It is always risky to go on a mission trip, and we had lots of challenges while we were there. Our mode of transportation continued to break down, and once I thought we were going to be stranded completely. But thankfully we were able to repair the vehicle and we defeated the enemy who was trying to destroy us! Christ says that those who believe in the Gospel and his Word will be scattered to carry the Gospel with power and protection. I want to thank the people and churches of our association who make it possible for us to go on these mission trips. Together we are reaching the world for Christ. We were able to lead over 60 people to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior!
