
November:

Claiming God's Promises for 2016

January: Isaiah 43:5 Do not be afraid, for I am with you.

Lord, I claim your promise and find great peace in knowing that you are always with me and always will be. My heart does not need to be afraid because of the assurance of your presence and companionship. Help me to rest in this truth today.

February: I John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Lord, I thank you for this promise of forgiveness and cleansing, as I am willing to confess my sins to you. When I do sin, Lord, help me to have enough sense to come to you and humbly repent and claim your forgiveness. And please, dear Lord, help me learn to stay away from those people or things that lead me into sin.

March: Matt 7:7-8 Ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; he who seeks, finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened.

What a precious promise from you, dear Lord. I can rely on you to keep this promise. Today, I will ask, seek, and knock. Give me peace and patience to wait on you, eagerness to discover your purposes, and faith to trust your will even when I do not understand.

April: Matt 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Dear Lord, you know how easy it is for me to worry about so many things. I need to be reminded of this promise whenever I begin to worry, which is really my fear that you are not going to take care of me. Today I claim this promise of your provision for my life. I trust you to take care of everything that concerns me.

May: Matt 11:28-30 Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

Dear Lord Jesus, you know how easy it is for me to feel weary and burdened with life's difficulties. I roll my burdens onto your shoulders. I willingly take your yoke of Lordship so you can handle the burdens and I may experience your peace.

June: Ps 32 :8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel and watch over you.

Dear Heavenly Father, thank you for your promise to teach and counsel me and watch over me, too! I claim that promise today along with the peace that comes from knowing you are in charge of me and all that concerns me. I will rejoice in your love and seek eagerly for your guidance. July: John 10:10 I have come that they (my sheep) may have life and have it to the full (abundantly.)

Dear Lord Jesus, how wonderful it is to be one of your sheep! You died that I may have eternal life, and it is your desire that I also live my earthly life to the full. I claim this promise of abundant life. Please help me not to settle for anything less today...and every day.

August: John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. (See also: Ps 37:11; Ps 85:8)

Dear Lord, please help me realize today that you have given me your peace. It is my responsibility to claim this promise, accept your peace, and do my part to dispel trouble and worry from my mind and heart. As I focus on you, the 'peace-giver,' and refuse to listen to a trouble or fearful heart, I will have your peace. (See also: Ps 37:11; Ps 85:8)

September: Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.

Father God, what a joy to claim this promise. You are my shelter in the storms of life. You are my strength when I am weak. You are always with me and ever so dear to me when trouble comes. I will take my rest in this promise today, whether it is a day of great joy or one of deep trouble. Your presence is my peace. (See also: Ps 46:7,11; Ps 86:7; Ps 91:15-16)
