Time "Marches" on! There is a time for everything. I believe it's time for the church to really look at why we exist. I'm excited about leading the Spring Bible Study. We will be looking at a book by Henry and Richard Blackaby, *Flickering Lamps: Christ and His Church*. We are in the middle of the season of Lent. This is a time of reflection, repentance, and renewal. We do this to remember Jesus' time in the wilderness, before beginning His ministry. Many of you are fasting from certain things in your life in order to live sacrificially reminding you of Jesus' sacrifice for us. During this fasting, many use this time to pray and seek God. I believe just as we need individual reflection, repentance, and renewal, this should be reflected as a church.

Blackaby says this, in *Flickering Lamps*, "The risen Christ walks among today's churches. His fiery eyes look upon your congregation. He sees your past activities, programs, and doctrines, straight to your heart. Are you as devoted to Him as you once were? Have you kept your focus on your divine purpose as a congregation? Is our church clearly enjoying the pleasure and blessing of God? Is God working powerfully in your midst? Is the community around your church being significantly changed for good by your church's presence? Heed the words of the risen Christ: *'Remember then how far you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. Otherwise, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place-unless you repent.'*

I pray that we as a church, spend the season of Lent in reflection, asking God to show us where we need to repent, and then be obedient in what He calls, us to do.

Is your church planning a revival this spring? Let us know, we'd love to pray for and with you. We will be making a list, to not only help promote, but also to pray!

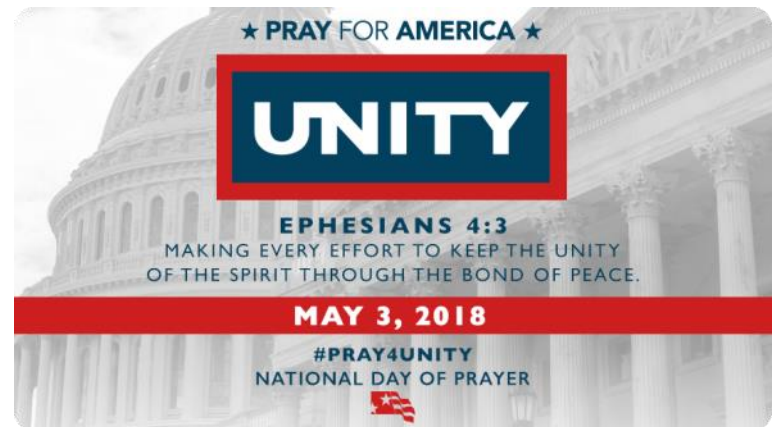
