Last month we finished up a three part series on partnerships. I wanted to share with you a great story of this in action. I was praying about asking someone to build a ramp for one of our retired pastors who is coming home soon from a rehab facility and is having some trouble walking. God led me to call Russ Bradley at New Hope Baptist to see if their men may have the time to do it soon. He then explained that they were kind of in a pickle because they had committed to build a ramp for a family in their community, but several on their team had experienced several life issues and sickness and were short a few men to complete the project in time. I then asked him if he'd like for me to contact another church and see about partnering together. He said that would be great! So I called Mike Shumate at Union Baptist and explained what Russ had told me. They got together and completed the project together!! A perfect example of partnering together.

The size of the congregation does not matter. (I am working on an article about the size of a church for next month.) What matters is ministering to the needs of those in our communities for the purpose of showing and sharing the gospel of Jesus.

Here's another great story. Pastor Ted and Immanuel Baptist have been ministering to a young lady in their community who is a recovering addict. She just recently had a baby. The church has been trying to help her with resources, but mainly they had been providing transportation for her to get to work. The pastor and a couple of other church members were taking her to work and picking her up. She was working 2nd and 3rd shift. So there were late night and early morning trips to her job in Blacksburg, SC. One morning at our Grover/Kings Mountain Pastor's Fellowship, Ted mentioned the need for a car for this young lady. We prayed about it. A couple of days later, a young couple contacted the GCCBA office asking if we knew anyone in need of a car! We connected the couple with Pastor Ted, and the church took care of the paperwork to get this young lady a car!! What a great story of partnering together for ministry!

I'd love to share more stories of partnerships in ministry! Who are you partnering with? Are you looking for partners in ministry? How are you helping your community together? Do they see the body of Christ in action? Remember, two are better than one.

THE PRAYER AND THE WAY TO OFFER IT TO GOD

"PSALM 42:4 "I remember these things, and I pour out my soul within me; how I went with the crowd, and I led her to the house of God. Among voices of joy and praise of the people in celebration. Why are you cast down, O my soul, and are you disturbed within me? Wait on God, because I have yet to praise Him, my salvation and my God."

The power of the servant of God and of the congregation comes from prayer. We have insisted that a church, however small it may be, is impacted by prayer. Our lives are also affected by prayer. The Psalmist offers his prayer from the bottom of his soul. It's like talking to yourself and being comforted; it brings a feeling of security. The Psalmist possibly had a series of problems, including depression, but he knew the secret during his crisis. He waited patiently in prayer in the power of God. He had the confidence that God would respond. Today, we all receive this power, but many keep it under lock and key, and some only briefly unlock it. The servant and the church are those who always have time for prayer. The Psalmist teaches "patience" because He knew God would respond. When reading in detail, it is as if the Psalmist told the readers that there is no reason to be sad, worried, in crisis, anxious, desperate or depressed. Like the Psalmist had difficulty, I think you and I have to learn from hardship and externalize all the evil that exists in us and offer to be cleansed through our prayers. So, to pray is really to place all my trust in God (Psalm 56:9; 86:7; John 5:14). We need to pray with a fervent heart (1 Thessalonians 3:10; James 5:17). We need to Pray with a prepared heart (Job 11:13). We pray with a true heart that we would receive a response to everything (Hebrews 10:22). We need to pray with desire (Psalm 27:7; 102:2; 108:6). The Word of God teaches me that I should be in prayer for 24 hours every single day. Take a test, look at yourself, see how much time you spend having intimacy with Christ. Be honest. Then ask for forgiveness. We need your family, your church, your county, your state, your nation, and your world, brothers and sisters. God's order should begin to be fulfilled, PRAY WITHOUT CEASING, and pray with all your heart with the hope of being heard, to be forgiven, to be understood, to do it with faith, to do it with humility, with sincere lips, with persistence, with full assurance of faith, with personal reflection, with holiness, with submission to God, with all our heart, and with truth. 
