The Shelby Star, April 29, 2019, headline read: "Clover Hill UMC will close in June." This is a sad story that hits very close to home. I understand the policy of the United Methodist Church lead to this church closing. It was not the members decision, however The Star article did say that a decline in membership and finances led to the decision. This story is one of 6,000 to 10,000 churches every year in the U.S. (Facts & Trends, January 16, 2018- "Hope for Dying Churches," Thom Rainer). In the Facts and Trends article, Rainer gives some great hope for the church. Two thirds of American churches are in need of revitalization. Using that statistic, that's fifty-six of our eighty-four churches that need revitalization.

Thom Rainer has written a great little book that I believe EVERY church in our association needs to read, "Autopsy of a Deceased Church: 12 Ways To Keep Yours Alive." You can order from Lifeway, Amazon, or I'll be happy to order you several copies for your church.

Rainer looks at fourteen churches who closed their doors and shares common things that were taking place that led to the church closing. I'll give some in this months article for you to chew on, think about and talk about in your church. Is this your church?

1. The past was the hero-"Church was fighting for the past. The good old days. The way they want it to be."
2. The Church Refused to Look Like the Community- "Dying churches are concerned with self-preservation. They are concerned with a certain way of doing church." "Their doors are closed to the community."
3. The Budget Moved Inwardly -"We hold on to things because we want our way of life. Our comfort. Our possessions." "They spend for their way of doing church. Their comfort. Their possessions."
4. The Great Commission Becomes the Great Omission- "Thriving churches have the Great Commission as the centerpiece of their vision, while dying churches have forgotten the clear command of Christ." "They stopped going. And making disciples. And baptizing them. And teaching them."
5. The Preference-Driven Church- "My Music style. My desired length and order of worship services. My color of buildings and rooms. My activities and programs. My need of ministers and staff. My, my,my."
