'They **devoted** themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to **prayer**. ' Acts 2:42

Last month. I shared five of the ten common symptoms of the fourteen churches from Thom Rainer's, "Autopsy of a Deceased Church." Here are the final five:

6. Pastoral Tenure Decreases- "For the majority of the churches, pastors came and went at a pace of every two to three years, especially in the two decades leading to the deaths of the churches." The church would call a pastor in hopes of changing the decline. They would make a few changes, church members would not like them, then the pastor would leave. Sometimes on their own, other times they were fired. It became cyclic.

7. The Church Rarely Prayed Together- During the interviews of the leaders from the deceased churches, it was revealed that the churches were not having meaningful prayer times. There were times of prayer, but they had become routine or ritualistic. "Not coincidentally, prayer and the health of the church went hand in hand. When the church is engaged in meaningful prayer, it becomes both the cause and the result of greater church health." The church stopped praying with passion as it once did.

8. The Church Had No Clear Purpose- "The churches were purposeless. They were engaged in an activity called, "This is the way we've always done it. None of the members asked what they should be doing; the were too busy doing what they've always done." **"A church without a gospel-centered purpose is no longer a church at all."**

9. The Church Obsessed Over the Facilities- "Church fights have erupted over stained glass windows, pews, draperies, paint color, carpet color, and on and on and one. Dying churches, more often than not, experience severe battles over facility obsession before their demise."

10. Slow Erosion- "It is rare for a long term church member to see erosion in his or her church. Growth my come rapidly, but decline is a usually slow, imperceptibly slow. This slow erosion is the worst type of decline for churches, because the members have no sense of urgency to change."

I purposefully shared number ten last. Many don't see it. Decline in the church happens slowly, over decades. Rainer says,

Thoughts from our Staff.....

"Often the decline is the physical facilities, but it's much more than that. The decline is in vibrant ministries that once existed. The decline is in the prayer lives of the members who remain. The decline is in the outward focus of the church. The decline is in the connection with the community. The decline is in the hopes and dreams of those who remain. Decline is everywhere in the church, but many don't see it."

As you read these, I challenge you to take last month's list and look at them all as you prayerfully ask God to reveal to you if you are experiencing any of these symptoms. There is hope!! Next month, I'll share Rainer's response to the symptoms. Remember the book has a subtitle, "...12 ways to keep yours alive." Share and discuss with church leaders. We would love to have a conversation with you to help your church become healthy, revive or die well. If you haven't read the book, those will make more sense next month.

Receive the Gospel, and bring the Gospel to every creature. All this is possible because we have an organization called GCCBA that is concerned about the expansion of the kingdom of God in Cleveland County. These achievements are also the crown of the churches of this county that provide resources that are being well used. We also want to say that as an association we have been intentionally training leaders, and we are beginning to see the fruits of men and women who are prepared to present the defense of the Gospel of Jesus Christ in this community. We bless their pastors, we bless their churches, and we thank all efforts that result in new believers, new members, and newly baptized people. We hope that this summer we can also continue working with children and young people who go on vacation and can offer special summer activities, such as VBS and church camps that offer activities that have to do with the childhood of Jesus Christ, with His ministerial life, His sacrifice, His resurrection, and His ascension. We are sure He will open a lot of doors during this time of recreation and vacation. We remind you that summer is the also a time to baptize, baptize, and baptize.


