Words from Wesley....

"Seek the Lord while He may be found; call to Him while He is near. Let the wicked one abandon his way and the sinful one his thoughts; let him return to the Lord so He may have compassion on him, and our God for He will freely forgive." Isaiah 55:6

Over the past few months I shared with you some great thoughts on church health from Thom Rainers book, "Autopsy of a Deceased Church." I pray that it has caused you to think and pray about where you are as a church. If you missed the last few newsletters, you can go to our website and click on Media, then Newsletters to see past newsletters.

Summer is officially over, school is back in and many of you are into your new church year. I erased how I ended the previous sentence. I had originally written, "and many of you are preparing to start your new church year." I pray that the preparation has already occurred. How will this upcoming church year be different than last year's? What steps have been made to seek the Lord's direction in the upcoming year? Do we need time before His throne, repenting and returning to God?

Isaiah instructed Israel to seek the Lord and return to Him. Abandon their way and return to the Lord so that He may have compassion on them. Isaiah tells Israel and the reader that God's thoughts are not our thoughts, and our ways are not God's ways. His ways are higher than ours.

My prayer is that we genuinely seek the Lord, repent, and walk in obedience to what He is leading us to do. Too many times I believe we just tweak what we did last year. Isaiah calls us to repentance and seeking the Lord. This is not a one time event. We should regularly come before God with humility and repenting hearts, seeking Him.

God promises in Isaiah 55:11 that He will accomplish what He desires and will prosper in what He does through His Word. Are we reading God's Word and seeking Him or are we just doing what we want to and then asking God to bless it?

We are praying for your upcoming church year, new Sunday School teachers, new deacons, new committee members, and new church leaders. Seek the Lord!

In my life and ministry, there are often times that I get frustrated because I do not get to see the fruits of my labor. This often happens at home as I straighten up only to come back in the room and see that it's a mess again, or when I finally finish the laundry and then see that my children (or husband!) have changed clothes again. Every one of us likes to see that what we do makes a difference. Often times, in churches and on mission trips, I see this happen. Maybe you have helped with a VBS at your church that is not well attended. Maybe you teach a children's Sunday School class, and you wonder if they are even listening much less learning anything. You may have been on a mission trip where you have helped with a block party where no one came or worked at a VBS that only had 2 kids. You maybe wondering where I am going with this, but hang with me.

I recently received a letter from Patrick Lynch, a church planter we work with in Indiana. In this letter, he wanted to thank us for the partnership we have with his church. In one paragraph, he said, "You all gave me the courage and support to go forward with a church plant even when at times I doubted that it would work". What a great reminder that even the small things we do can encourage someone and result in an eternal impact. We may never see hundreds of people accept Christ at a block party in Indiana, our help and encouragement allows them to continue doing God's work.

I hope you will take time now to think and pray about who needs an encouragement and what you can do to help. Does your pastor need a kind word to encourage him to carry on or is there a small church down the street that could use help with a block party? Find ways to encourage others and rest assured that God will use your efforts to glorify himself.
