Words from Wesley....

"His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, according to his eternal purpose that he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord. " Ephesians 3:10-11

Over the past several months, I have been sharing some of Dr. Thom Rainers thoughts from "Autopsy Of A Deceased Church." In last months article, I shared with you Dr. Rainers, "Seven Symptoms Of A Dying Church," from his Rainer On Leadership podcast episode 529. If you haven't looked at those symptoms and asked God to reveal symptoms of sickness in your church, I challenge you to do so. Ninety percent of our churches will have some symptoms.

When someone is given a diagnosis of sickness, or disease, there is that initial moment of shock, and then they move on to treatment. I want to be clear, each church is unique and different. There is NO one way or just a "cookie cutter" way, to revitalize a church. See number six below. I pray that the following is helpful for you.

This month, I want to share with you from Dr. Rainer's podcast, Revitalize and Replant, episode 113, "Anatomy Of A Revived Church: Seven Findings Of How Congregations Avoided Death."

Using the same method of research, Rainer interviewed churches that were dying and made changes to escape death. He found these seven common characteristics.

1. Accepting Responsibility
 - a. They didn't blame anyone but themselves, accepting responsibility for their condition. They quit blaming the community, the pastor, the denomination, etc.
2. Overcoming the Traps of Tradition
 - a. Nothing was off the table when talking about change. They went beyond traditions.
3. Expanding the Scorecard
 - a. Instead of looking at attendance and offerings to measure success, churches used other markers.
 - b. Increased Bible Study participation, small groups, disciple-making, baptisms.

4. Committing to Powerful Prayer
 - a. Revived churches got serious about prayer and prayed for other churches in their community
5. Dealing with Toxins
 - a. Continued toxins must be dealt with for churches to escape death. Toxic=continued divisiveness
 - b. Note there is a difference between a toxic person and a critic.
6. Seeking Silver Bullets No More
 - a. Churches stopped looking for the magic program, young pastor, change in worship style, etc.
7. Creating Meaningful Membership Resources
 - a. Clear expectations, and assimilation of new members.
 - b. Creating ways to serve in the church before becoming a member

'Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen.' Ephesians 3:20-21



Each week during staff prayer time we each take a church to pray for. I always pray for the church to continue to reach out and engage their community. As the church, we are called to minister to our neighbors, and the streets around our church building are a good place to start. In the last edition of the Biblical Recorder, there was an article entitled, "4 Steps to Engage your Community," by Joe Maye. In the article, he shares practical steps a church can take to engage their community. I want to share the first two with you this month. Number 1: Be a person of prayer. In order to reach our communities, we must become connected with them so that we can pour into them. Praying for the Lord to turn our hearts to love our neighbors is a good first step. Number 2: Be a learner. To reach out to our communities, we must first understand them. We cannot impose our ideas or preferences on them, but must meet them where they are. As we look around our community, we need to look for opportunities that we can join in to better understand the people. Looking to be involved in sporting events, seasonal celebrations, social gatherings, and service projects is a great way to learn about the heartbeat of your community.

THE VISION TO NICARAGUA CONTINUES ...

... and that repentance and forgiveness of sins be preached in his name in all nations beginning with Jerusalem. And you are witnesses of these things ... Luke 24: 47-48 ...

I have been carrying the word of God as a missionary to my land, Nicaragua, for over 18 years, and during all that time the nation has had different political periods that somehow I have stopped my missionary concerns, sometimes I was quite aggressive, at other times I was passive, and sometimes I decided to see the actions of men longing and praying to Christ and under the anointing of his Holy Spirit, I returned to carry out the missionary work. Five years ago, my wife and I decided to help the Prince of Peace Baptist Church in the city of Managua. There we found Pastor Pedro A. Calero Lopez. We made plans, and we started to dream. The church was beginning its construction; they had the foundations, a part with a roof in the area of the sanctuary, and the rest were some blocks that pointed to future doors and future windows. The Servant Peter dreamed, but the economy of the country prevented him from moving forward. We helped him dream and with the help of the Getsemani Baptist Church, that sent \$100 a month, we started the work. Then we participated in this vision to the churches of Greater Cleveland County. Some believed and helped us to build the first phase. We were persistent and we managed to celebrate with the church as they opened the first part. Now the new plans are to work together to buy a means of transportation, and join efforts to build 3 classrooms for Sunday School and a kitchen for serving others. All this we have valued at \$15,500 with a vision of time of about 3 to 4 years of work together with those churches that believe in these projects and that commit themselves to inviting us to cook repochetas for their members. We continue to preach the Word, calling people to repentance, helping them as God forgives their sins, and training them so they can do the same and reproduce in the Power of the Holy Spirit of God. I know that missionary work and working for the Lord is not an easy matter, it requires

suitable men and women. We are instructed to be prepared for all good work. We can only tell you that we are useless servants, but that God has been pleased with our gifts and talents and we are used in the plans of God. We give honor and glory in all that God has allowed us to do. We ask for your prayers. We ask for your support and your love for a small part of the Nicaraguan people, and we continue to invite you to go together and visit a land of men fighting for a better life, working tirelessly, and persisting in the midst of crises, in the midst of political struggles, and in the midst of a bad economy. We are the second poorest people in the world. But, we are also the most blessed people with the presence of Christ in our lives. We will continue forward, always faithful, always grateful for all that the Lord does in us. We pray because we have a fair, strong, good, faithful and loving people like the Cleveland County family. Blessings.

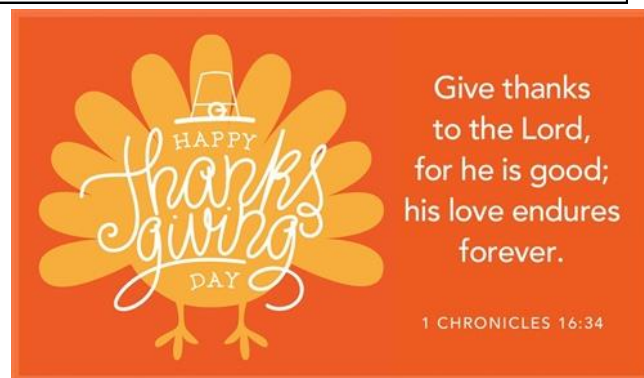
