Katie, Nicole and I attended the NC Associational Missions Conference at Caraway Conference Center on April 12-14. The theme of the Conference was **"Courageous and Compelling Leadership"** and our Guest Presenter was Dr. Jeff Iorg, the President of Gateway Theological Seminary (formerly Golden Gate Seminary). Dr. Iorg developed the theme in 5 sessions:

- Think/Live Like a Missionary
- Leading From the Inside Out
- Leading From the Outside In
- The Painful Side of Leadership
- Leading Major Change in Your Ministry

What a powerful speaker, leader and author he is with such insight and experience in the area of Christian Leadership. I encourage you to go to his website [jeffior.org](http://jeffior.org) to find out more information about his weekly blog, his seminars and his books.

We were led in worship throughout the Conference time by Rev. Kenny Lamm, the Senior Consultant for Worship and Music of the Baptist State Convention and Dr. Chris Schofield, the Director of the Office of Prayer for the BSCNC. He led us to focus on two themes from various Biblical texts and to spend some time in directed prayer around:

- Praying Toward Courageous Leadership
- God Still Calls His People Back to Himself

## **The world gets out of control because we don't want to subdue ourselves.**

*Romans 13:-1-3 "Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves. For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same."*

Civilized countries are full of regulations, laws, and statutes, which really allows the society not to run away, not to stumble, not to commit crimes. The laws put in place by men must be made known and the society must study and know them. The laws have been made because of evil. If you are a good man, you do not have to fear them. Paul wrote to the Romans asking for every person to submit to authority, for the authorities have been established by God. If the law requires it and you are on a good path, you do not have to oppose or offer resistance. But, we have seen that opponents are as involved in disorder, in the amoral, and in motivating the heart of justice to use force and violence. Later when force is used, the society protests, and in the midst of the protest, windows are broken, doors are burned, blocks and stones are burned, and the most painful of the protest is looting, which is nothing but brazen theft. Protesting in this way to seek justice seems to me to be incorrect. Paul tells the Christian people in Rome that those who oppose the established by God, God resists; those who resist, those who oppose in this way carry condemnation for themselves. Magistrates and police are there to instill fear to those who choose lives of evil. A good person is not intimidated by authority. Paul says, "Do you want then not to fear authority? Do good, live well, and I'm sure you'll always have praise and not jail and persecution." You are of Christ, you are a servant of God, you are a torch to justice, and you are a paladin of freedom. The army carried a sword to stop the evil one and his actions. It's like a servant of God, it's there to avenge, to punish the one who does evil. If you have been involved in strikes, in protests, and have reflected that your actions have been correct and righteous, then you have done well; otherwise, you have become an instrument of evil, of violence, and of vandalism. The man of God holds himself as righteous, not only to avoid punishment, but to remain in integrity. We trust that you, as a Christian, will be a person who submits to authority. Blessings. 
# Missions Opportunities


