THOUGHTS FROM LELAND . . .

"Fill the Tank" is a statewide baptism emphasis initiated by the new Executive Director-Treasurer of the Baptist State Convention of NC, Rev. Todd Unzicker. Churches are asked to fill their baptism tanks on Sunday, September 12 as we trust God to save souls between now and then.

Rev. Scott Setzer, Associational Missionary for the South Roanoke Baptist Association in Greenville, NC and the President of the NC Associational Missions Conference shared the following with his Association about **"Fill the Tank"**, and I asked him for permission to share it with our churches:

Pray and Trust God for a Harvest. *Most of us plan baptism services after we know we have people to baptize. Participating in Fill the Tank can cause a bit of anxiety because churches are being asked to set aside a day for baptisms even if they currently do not have any folks ready to be baptized. Well, we can fret about this, or we can pray and trust God to provide a harvest. I vote we pray and trust God! Many churches will be holding Vacation Bible School and sending children and teens to summer camp. Pray for God to bring a harvest from these events. I'm sure there are other activities in which your church will be engaged in the coming months that will provide opportunities to yield a harvest.*

Prepare to Share. *Gearing up for Fill the Tank gives us the opportunity for evangelism training. There are all kinds of ways to share the gospel. One of the most effective ways is telling your story of how Jesus saved you. Gospel sharing tools can be found at fillthetanknc.org. One of the best ways to prepare to share is to practice when you are with fellow believers. Carve out time during Sunday School and small group gatherings to share your story with others. The midweek prayer gathering is also a good setting for evangelism training. If your church would like to know more, I'm happy to help!*

Take it Outside! *Hold your baptism service outdoors. Head to a park, town common, the river, the lake, or your church lawn. Use a large inflatable pool, a tarp in the bed of a pickup truck, or a galvanized stock tank.*

Join other (GCCBA) Churches in your Community. *Wouldn't it be awesome if several churches that had 1-2 candidates got together to celebrate with each other? This is a perfect time to hold the service in a space outside of the church walls as well.*

Thoughts from our Staff.....

Make it a Party! After all, we are celebrating new life in Christ! People like parties, so provide invitations for baptism candidates to send to family members and friends. Be sure to share the gospel with those who attend and invite them to respond to God's free gift of grace through Jesus Christ. Oh, and serve refreshments! It's not a party without cake!

Involve Others. Two highlights of my life were baptizing my children. Offer parents the privilege of baptizing their children. Ask folks who God used to lead another person to faith in Christ if they would like to baptize that person as well.

Practice Planned Spontaneity. I know this sounds like an oxymoron but hear me out. Add a different element to your service by inviting people in attendance to be baptized along with those who are already scheduled for baptism. After sharing the gospel, you can ask something along the lines of what the Ethiopian eunuch asked Philip in Acts 8:36, "Look, here's water. What is keeping you from being baptized? Of course, you will need to make sure you have appropriate garments for those who are baptized.

Determine to Disciple. This emphasis provides a prime opportunity to develop a discipleship pathway for your church. Spend time training disciple makers who will walk with new believers and help them grow in the faith. We must not forget that teaching people to observe all that Christ commanded is a crucial part of fulfilling the Great Commission (Matthew 28:20).

Will you pray for people in our community to respond to the gospel and take the next step of obedience through baptism? Will you plan now to participate in "**Fill the Tank**" on September 12? You can find registration and practical resource material at fillthetanknc.org.

Missions Opportunities

School & Church Partnerships

Our churches have some many great ministry opportunities right in their backyard. None of these are greater than the local school. As we draw closer to the time when the school bells ring we need to start thinking and praying about how you can support your local school. Ryan Nelson, who use to work for Young Life and now teaches bible studies on various websites offers these ideas:



1. **Start a sports league:** Whether you have your own field or court, or you use one that's available to the public, starting a sports league is a great way for your church to build relationships with others in the community. This doesn't have to be a huge undertaking, either. Games like cornhole require a minimal investment, and you can set them up just about anywhere.
2. **Set up a backpack drive:** School supply costs add up fast, and the burden on families only seems to increase each year. Consider coordinating with local schools to create a list of supplies, and then ask your congregation to either purchase supplies or donate to a backpack drive fund
3. **Prepare a back-to-school bash:** This is essentially a community party, and it's a chance for your church to go big. You could partner with local businesses and encourage them to donate supplies, clothes, food, services, or games and activities to make this event something your community will remember.
4. **Encourage church members to volunteer at schools:** Schools can always use volunteers. Whether they need more help supervising at recess or detention, coaching on school teams, or support for group activities, encourage your congregation to be that extra set of hands and be ambassadors for your church.
5. **Plan a teacher appreciation day:** Every year, National Teacher Appreciation Day is on Tuesday of the first full week of May. But that doesn't mean you can't celebrate teachers on other days, too.
6. **Invite teachers to church for a special service:** To kick off the school year, consider preparing a special service to honor and lift up teachers in your community. Plan to have a special time of prayer acknowledging the important role teachers have in your community and the world, and then serve them food and spend time with them after the service.

These are all great ways to partner and support your local schools. We are creating partnerships and asking churches to hold prayer walks at the schools. If you are interested in being a church partner or if you already are one please let us know. We want to make sure every school has one.
