Jeremiah 29:11 tells us, "For I know the plans I have for you" —this is the LORD's declaration—"plans for your well-being, not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope" (CSB).

Hello Cleveland County! My name is Jason Ballard, and I am joining you and the ministries of Baptist churches in the Greater Cleveland County Baptist Association as your new Associational Missionary. I want to thank you for your prayers for me and my family as we have made this new step together and as we transition to be a part of the family of believers in Cleveland County. In this, my first monthly newsletter, I just wanted you to get to know a little about me as I begin to get to know all of you and work with you in what God has in store for us to accomplish together.

I grew up in west Gastonia and was a member of a Cleveland County church in my years as a youth. My parents are strong Christian believers who took my sister and I to church and showed us what it meant to follow God, serve God in His church, and to be a witness for Him locally and all over the world.

In the summer of 1999, I boarded a plane for India as a medical volunteer with the International Mission Board. Over the next 62 days I would immerse myself in another culture. I would experience the highs and lows of life and death in a developing country. I would make new friends and worship in a church with people who looked and sounded nothing like me. I would also go on a spiritual journey that God continues to use to lead me today.

However, the most significant moment for me came as I walked down the jet way to board my first flight. I had just checked my luggage that contained everything that tied me to home, hugged my parents and told them goodbye. At first, I thought it might be nerves or anxiety, but then it settled into a peaceful excitement. It was there, alone on that jet way that I realized something – I was exactly where God wanted me to be.

It was a brief moment, but one I cherish to this day, because it reminds me that when we are obedient to God's will – no matter how great the challenge is before us – God will be with us through whatever may come, and God will bring joy in that journey. It is with that same excitement and responsibility that I make my way to Cleveland County.

We can use all size cans. Some locations prefer #10 cans (family size).






