Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. Romans 12:1

Have you ever noticed how one "yes" can change your life. My "yes" came in 1994 when I agreed to go on my first mission trip. Even though I only went to be a "glorified PE teacher" for a backyard Bible club, God used that week to challenge me on my commitment to Him. From that experience, He has taken me on a journey that has introduced me to His work on four continents and has allowed me to witness the salvation and discipleship of many people to God's glory and credit – and none of my own.

I can't help but wonder sometimes what my life would have been like if I hadn't said "yes" to such a simple task. How would my direction in life be different? How would the lives I have interacted with be different? How would this world be different?

I've heard it said, probably in a sermon, that being a "living sacrifice," is like saying yes to do whatever God wants, before He tells you what that is.
