Bi-Annual Meeting Messengers

Each church shall elect annually, in addition to the pastor, two (2) messengers to the meetings of the Association for each fifty (50) members of the church, provided each church shall not have less than three (3) nor more than ten (10) messengers ALONG WITH ALL ASSOCIATIONAL OFFICERS, these shall constitute the voting body of the Association. The names of the messengers printed in the minutes shall Include only those in attendance and registering at the Associational Meetings.

By-Law II Meetings, Section 3

Items of Business to be presented from the floor must be submitted in writing to the Associational Office at least 30 days prior to the first session of the Biannual Meeting.

Thoughts from our Staff

"See, I have placed before you and open door that no one can shut. I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name."

Revelation 4:8b

In one of my favorite movies, The Lord of the Rings: The Two Towers, there is a scene that I think well describes our churches. In this scene a king is confronted by what appears to be an unbeatable foe, and in response he shrinks in fear. One of the main characters begs the king to be brave and "ride out" against their foe, but in careful consideration the king chooses to not only retreat, but to move his people to a secluded stronghold to weather the attacks of the oncoming enemy.

Sometimes I believe our churches look at the enemy that stands in front of them and rather than "ride out" in faith following the commands of God, we retreat to where we think we will be safe only to find that our enemy will find us there as well.

In Revelation 4, God sends a message to the church at Philadelphia that He has opened a door, and whatever door He opens will remain open, they only need to choose to go through it. In our world we need churches and leaders that look at our enemy, that measure our resources and that count the cost, but are still willing to "ride out" in faith to fulfill God's call to be a church that carries the gospel to the world, to be a church that loves the people who are hurting, and to be a church that builds community within our walls to impact the community outside our walls. A church that regardless of size is *transformational*!

At 11:00 AM on April 13th, Dr. Iorg will be meeting our pastors in our monthly pastor's conference. And let my Jesus change your life


