"As [Jesus] approached and saw the city, he wept for it... Luke 19:41

I know that Jesus must have cried more than once, but I usually only equate "Jesus weeping" to one verse of scripture – John 11:35. In Luke 19, however, Jesus is weeping because he recognizes what the people of Jerusalem are missing – Him! When I read this passage, I can't help but feel the frustration and discouragement of our savior. The answer to their needs, to their brokenness, to their pain is walking along their streets but they can't see Him. They ignore the answer because all they can see is the hurt. It makes me wonder what Jesus sees when He looks at us.

Recently several pastors and I ventured north to the city of Baltimore, Maryland to explore some mission partnership opportunities. As we toured the city and met with pastors, church planters, and even church members; I was struck by both the need for the gospel and the concern for it among some very dedicated servants of gospel. Everywhere we went the streets were busy. Restaurants were swamped with people. The hustle and bustle of a major metropolis was evident...until you went to a church.

One church planter we visited is working among the urban poor so his "regular attenders" includes those for whom we often would call security. The homeless, the addict and the

downtrodden often occupy the "seats in his sanctuary," but the joy is in giving them Jesus. Another church has declined significantly due to a shrinking ethnic population, but a young planter we met is planning how to bring life back to this congregation as they reach out to a community in need. This is very similar to yet another planter we met who has "replanted" in a First Baptist Church that had all but closed its doors.

Much like, Jesus, when we looked at the city we were moved by their need and their struggle, but mostly by the presence of Jesus among them. These planters and churches are laboring in a city where Satan wants the spiritual testimony to look much like one church we encountered where the front doors were locked with a simple sign – "No Trespassing!"

As we explore future opportunities to connect our churches in this mission field only a few hours away, pray how God may be calling your church to join. Pray for how your men's ministry can go and assist churches that are trying to renovate spaces that are in desperate need of repair.

Pray that your youth and young adult ministries can go and be a part of bringing relief to the urban poor and those distant from God. Pray how adults in your community can join in the work of these planters and replanters as they seek to become the hands of Christ that embrace those who just don't see Him. And pray for how you may step onto a mission field, not too far from home and experience the heart of Jesus that weeps for a city and we point them to the savior.


