In order for the GCCBA to achieve this amended mission, we have adopted 6 missional values.

Pastoral health, Congregational health, Leadership development, Ministry support, Community engagement, and Mission partnership.

Missions has been a passion of mine since I was a 15-year-old kid on his first mission trip to Toronto, Canada. I spent that week singing in a youth choir and serving as the PE teacher for our "Backyard Bible Club" in a Toronto suburb. Since that day, I have served in over 40 national mission trips doing everything from construction to visiting senior citizens. I have traveled internationally to three continents working in a hospital in India, leading a pastors' conference in Zimbabwe, and helping to coordinate a Bible camp in Hungary. Missions is just something that gets me excited!

In every experience, I have been amazed to see not only what God has done through a willing team that was stretched out of their comfort zone to make an impact for Christ, but I have watched as the experience has transformed those who ventured out on the mission trip to begin with. To put it succinctly, when we go, we get so much more than we give.

Part of the reason for the unexpected blessing is that inevitably, every time I've gone on mission, I went knowing that there was a team of people praying for the trip, the team, the travel, and the outcome. Prayer makes all the difference in the world to the mission team and to those the team ministers to as well.

This summer I will be leading a team of high school students and adults to Antigua, Guatemala, in June. This will be the first time the GCCBA has been to Guatemala and the first time our partner, Mission Serve, has sent a team into the Antigua area. We will be conducting home visits to share the gospel and leading two two-day VBS programs. In the VBS programs alone, we anticipate working with 200 to 300 kids. In addition, we are looking to bless several churches and ministries in this area. Please pray for our team as they prepare to go. Pray that we will be safe in travel. Pray that we will be prepared for our ministry

opportunities (planned and unplanned). Pray that we can bond as a team as we are called upon to minister in a place that we have never been. Pray that the outcome of the trip will be successful and the outcome for our team will be impactful for their future walk with Christ.

Following the Guatemala trip, I will be coordinating a mission project in Spruce Pine, NC in July for the Hurricane Helene relief efforts that are still ongoing. We will have around 350 student and adult volunteers for one week serving those still trying to put their lives back together. We still have space if your student ministry is looking for a mission trip and want to make a difference in NC this summer. Please contact the GCCBA for more information, and regardless of whether you can go or not – please pray for us as we serve those in need of a helping hand and the love of the gospel.

Thank you for allowing me to do something I love and lead others to experience missions for the first time in this state and to the ends of the earth!

I had the privilege the other evening to see the Christian band Sanctus Real in concert. 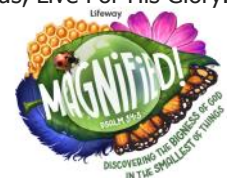
