Annual Meeting Messengers

By-Law II Meetings, Section 3: Each church shall elect annually, in addition to the pastor, two (2) messengers to the meetings of the Association for each fifty (50) members of the church, provided each church shall not have fewer than three (3) nor more than ten (10) messengers. THESE ALONG WITH ALL ASSOCIATIONAL OFFICERS, shall constitute the voting body of the Association. The names of the messengers printed in the minutes shall include only those in attendance and registering at the Associational Meetings.

By-Law II Meetings, Section 4: Items of Business to be presented from the floor must be submitted in writing to the Associational Office at least 30 days prior to the first session of the Biannual Meeting.

Thoughts from Staff

The GCCBA exists to build (and rebuild) healthy churches

In order for the GCCBA to achieve this amended mission, we have adopted 6 missional values.

Pastoral health, Congregational health, Leadership development, Ministry support, Community engagement, and Mission partnership.

Last month, I informed you of our new schedule for our Fall Annual meeting that will be held on Sunday, October 19th, at Mt. Sinai Baptist Church at 4:00 PM. Yes, that means the meeting is not on a Monday night! All of this has been made possible by what many consider the most mundane of acts – the changing of the GCCBA bylaws! I know that does not sound exciting, but I must be honest for me it is.

Typically, in the churches I have served, Bylaws fall somewhere just underneath the stone tablets of Moses in their degree of importance and permanence, but in all actuality, the Bylaws of any church should remain flexible enough to enable a church to accomplish ministry, rather than hinder it. This year, at our annual meeting on October 19th, the Leadership Team of the GCCBA will be presenting a full revision of our Bylaws for vote and adoption.

The purpose of this revision was to perform some necessary maintenance on our core documents by clarifying language that was antiquated and needed updating, and to change functional instructions to match the way in which we function today. However, the major function of this revision was to reorient the bylaws around the missional values adopted by the association in the Spring 2024 meeting. These Missional Values have shaped all that we plan on our calendar. They have shaped all that we do in our ministry efforts. They have even shaped our budget and our communications. Therefore, it is only natural that they become the center of our bylaws as well.

These Missional Value Teams have not only been included in the bylaws, but they are now central to the leadership team structure and the overall direction of the GCCBA. You can review the new bylaws by following the QR code on the front of this newsletter.

You will note that the bylaws now include a clear definition of a cooperating church as a church that EITHER gives financially to the GCCBA, sends a messenger to the annual meeting, OR has a member or staff member serve on an associational team all during a rolling three-year period. This was done in an attempt to offer every church an opportunity to participate and maintain their identity in the GCCBA, but also to allow our leadership a method and means to remove churches who no longer participate in any of our functions.

It is the heartfelt desire of the Leadership Team and the Bylaw Revision sub-team that these new Bylaws will establish a new expectation of cooperation among our churches as we unite congregations in effective missions and ministry all across the county and around the world.
