In order for the GCCBA to achieve this amended mission, we have adopted 6 missional values.

***Pastoral health, Congregational health, Leadership development, Ministry support, Community engagement, and Mission partnership.***

In his book, Leadership 101, John C. Maxwell states, "A leader is great, not because of his or her power, but because of his or her ability to empower others." Later, Maxwell expounds the value of leadership when he explains, "You win people's hearts by helping them grow personally." The problem we often find is that pastoral leaders do not make training new leaders one of their pastoral goals and so after a long tenure in his church, when it is time to ride off into the sunset, or just to the next ministry assignment the church finds that the strength of their leadership outside of the pastor is weak. This is why the GCCBA values the importance of Leadership Development and has made it one of our missional values.

The Leadership Development team of the GCCBA serves the local church by overseeing our leader training events that take place twice a year. The next event is scheduled for November 17th with Dr. Stephen Fisher, superintendent of Cleveland County Schools, local church member and Sunday School teacher in the GCCBA and lover of all things leadership focused. Dr. Fisher and I will be presenting on the subject of developing a leadership pipeline, raising up leaders in your church and equipping them for growth.

The Leadership Development team of the GCCBA also oversees the Blueprint for Faithful Ministry program (formerly Residency Project) that equips new pastors, current church staff and those individuals feeling the call to the pastorate, to explore what it takes to build a ministry framework for the local church as a pastor. Out of this program we have already seen multiple interims called and one pastor. We look forward to developing more pastoral leaders.

In addition, the Leadership Development team of the GCCBA will oversee the Timothy and Titus project that we look to launch in the coming months for students who are considering the call to ministry. These young disciples are facing questions of what does the call to ministry look like? What colleges should I consider? How do I begin serving now? This project will seek to equip those feeling this call with a clearer understanding of what it means to follow our Lord into full-time ministry.

# Thoughts from Staff

Moreover, the Leadership Development team of the GCCBA will be developing and launching regional training seminars. These seminars will focus on subjects such as "Strengthening your Membercare Program," "Developing the Teachers Among You," and "Equipping Disciple-makers in your Pews." These seminars will be led by local pastors as we work together to "unite local congregations in effective missions and ministry!"

So, do not miss this month's Leadership Training event on November 17th at Bethlehem Baptist Church in Kings Mountain. The meal will kick-off with supper at 6 PM and our training will commence at 6:45 PM. Don't miss this great opportunity to "...win people's hearts by helping them grow personally!"
