Thoughts from our Staff

If you have read the past few newsletters, you know that I have been sharing about our revisioning here at the GCCBA. Our mission remains as it has been with an amended focus:

The GCCBA exists to build (and rebuild) healthy churches

<u>B</u>}

uniting congregations in effective missions and ministry!

In order for the GCCBA to achieve this amended mission, we have adopted 6 missional values. **Pastoral health, Congregational health, Leadership development, Ministry support, Community engagement, and Mission partnership.**

On April 29th, we will hold our Spring Biannual Meeting at David Baptist Church in Kings Mountain, NC, and I will be sharing the impact our six missional values will have on our association. Since it is not possible for each and every one of our churches and members to be present, I wanted to take the next few newsletters to expand and explain these Missional Values and explore how they will be impacting our association. We will begin with Pastoral Health.

In our world today, many experts have described the "job" of the pastor (or any minister) as one of the most stressful and challenging "jobs" that exist. As you can imagine, they carry the burden of care for each of their church members, often on confidential issues or health crises. They also bear the responsibility of leading the organization of the church, from the committees and administration to the facility and grounds. Then, as if that wasn't enough, we call on them to open the Word of God each Sunday and bring us a fresh word from the Lord. With these responsibilities comes physical, emotional and spiritual stress and since the COVID pandemic, the tole has become more evident as pastors who were considered successful and strong in their ministries have begun stepping aside and retiring.

This has presented the GCCBA with a responsibility of caring for and nurturing the pastors of our churches who frequently are the least cared for members of any church. We do this monthly with our Pastors' Conference that meets on the first Monday of each month. We invite guest speakers from our state convention partners, local mission partners, and resource partners who offer helpful support for pastors in their leadership. In addition, this time creates a small group support among our pastors with prayer and encouragement. Then once a year we offer the Restore retreat for pastors and spouses at Ridgecrest where past speakers have been Dr. Danny Akin and Dr. Sandy Marks. Lastly, the GCCBA offers several connections to confidential counseling for pastors in times of crisis or need.

The GCCBA recognizes the stress placed on our pastors and our responsibility to care for their needs. Take time today to encourage and pray for your pastor. Ask them if they are aware of the monthly Pastors' Conference and encourage them to connect to other pastors through the GCCBA who want to encourage them. Since we believe that we can't build healthy churches without building healthy pastors, the GCCBA is committed to the health of our pastors. Join us in making sure we support our shepherds as they lead us in faith and life.

I am currently reading the book <u>Disciple</u> by Dr. Chuck Lawless, a professor at Southeastern Seminary. I have been especially challenged by the idea that he presents that a church needs to know who makes up their community so that there can be a strategically planned outreach strategy. He goes on to say that we expect missionaries to learn, study, and know the area they are going to be serving in yet as churches we don't know about who lives down the street from us. So we plan outreach events that are often not targeted to those who are in our communities. He also writes, "Our hearts are more likely to break over lostness when we know the faces and names of those lost people." So today I challenge you to consider if you really know the makeup of the community your church is trying to reach. And then think and pray about how your church's outreach strategy needs to look in order to reach your community. I would love to come and talk to your church or group about how you can better serve and reach out to those God has placed in your community.
